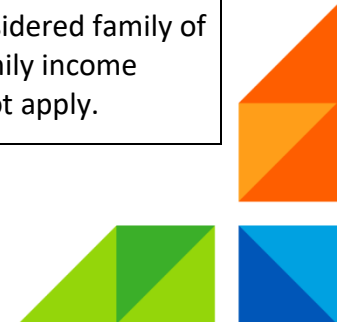

Youth who (a) received HS Diploma/equivalent and (b) is low-income and (c) is Deficient in Basic Literacy Skills or is an English language learner; <u>or</u> c. Required to attend school but has not attended for at least the most recent complete school year’s calendar quarter’; <u>or</u> d. Homeless or Runaway; <u>or</u> e. In foster care or aged out of foster care; <u>or</u> f. Pregnant/Parenting; <u>or</u> g. Subject to the juvenile or adult justice system; <u>or</u> h. Has a disability; <u>or</u> <p>Requires additional assistance to complete an educational program, or to secure and hold employment (must also meet low income requirements)</p>	<p>Authorized to work in U.S.</p>	<p>If male, registered as required</p>	<p>A.
